TRANSITIONS

Definition: Transitions are words or phrases that help tie ideas together; used between sentences and paragraphs.

Transitions to show *location*:

behind outside above by into across below down near over beneath in back of off throughout against along beside in front of to the right onto inside among between on top of under around beyond

around beyond

Transitions to show *time*:

about first meanwhile then soon after second today later next third tomorrow afterward at as soon as before till next week when immediately during until yesterday finally

Transitions which can be used to *compare two things* (*show similarities*):

likewise as in the same way

similarly like also

Transitions which can be used to *contrast things* (*show differences*):

but even so although otherwise on the other hand

however yet still even though

Transitions which can be used to *emphasize a point*:

again truly for this reason to repeat in fact to emphasize

Transitions which can be used to *conclude or summarize*:

as a result therefore in short finally lastly in summary to sum up all in all

Transitions which can be used to *add information*:

again another for instance finally also and moreover as well additionally besides

in addition next along with for example

Transitions which can be used to *clarify*:

that is for instance in other words
